1.1 Training flights

Training flights with repeated touch-and-go landings is discounted as follows

1-6 TGL plus one (1) full-stop landing, equals one (1) landing fee according to table above

7-12 TGL plus two (2) full-stop landings, equals two (2) landing fees according to table above

Please note that repeated touch-and-go landings is prohibited 22-06 LT

8 Fuel

9 De-icing

10 Extra opening, ATS increased charges

Additional fee, for services outside published hours of operation (according to AIP/NOTAM).

- Fee/started hour

- Fee/started hour
Monday-Friday 20:00-05:00 (LT)
Friday 20:00 through Monday 05:00 (LT) 1 050 /function*

During weekends, extra opening will be equivalent to a 3 hour minimum charge.

Request for additional hours during business days should be made at least 6 hrs prior to planned ETA/ETD

Requests for additional hours during weekends should be made no later than two business days before.

11 Snow removal

Snow removal runway, taxi & apron outside airport opening hours Monday-Friday 05:00-20:00 (LT) .

Includes friction test of the runway.

Chemical treatment not included, if needed price will be negotiated separately.

- Fixed fee including 3 hours of snow removal 5 500
- Fee after 3 hours 1 700 / hour

12 Fee exemptions/discounts

12.1 Following flights are exempted from landing fees at Hagfors airport

- Ambulanstransporter (HOSP) och liknande samhällsviktiga transporter av icke kommersiell karaktär (such flights also exempted from parking fee)
- Vintage aircraft, manufactured before 1964
- "Forced" returns to airport of departure, including technical and weather related issues

12.2 Following flights are discounted (landing and parking) with 50%, if operated during published opening hours

- School-flights (except repeated TGL as stated in paragraph 1.1),
- "PFT"
- Technical test-flights (non-revenue)

12.3 Exceptions to the price list

- The Airport Manager can make individual exemptions to this price list.

DEFINITIONS

AIP (Aeronautical Information Publication)

Is as a publication issued by or with the authority of a state and containing aeronautical information of a lasting character essential to air navigation. It is designed to be a manual containing thorough details of regulations, procedures and other information pertinent to flying aircraft in the particular country to which it relates. It is usually issued by or on behalf of the respective civil aviation administration.

MTOW (MAXIMUM TAKE OFF WEIGHT)

Where it is required to calculate the price, the weight factor will be determined based on the highest certified MTOW for which the aircraft is certified in its state of registration.

PASSENGER FLIGHTS

Are defined as flights with commercially paying passengers on board.

SGHA (IATA, Standard Ground Handling Agreement)

Agreement between airlines and ground handling service provider Hagfors Airport to manage all ground handling services at Hagfors Airport including fees.
